**CONSUMER PROTECTION REGULATIONS (TRIBUNAL
FOR CONSUMER CLAIMS) 1999**

15. Manner of service

- (1) Any notice or document required to be served to any person under these Regulations may be served by the following manners:
 - (a) personally;
 - (b) by acknowledged receipt registered post addressed to such person at his address for service or last-known address; or
 - (c) by electronic communication in accordance with the procedure as determined by the Tribunal.

- (2) Any notice or document required to be served to any person under these Regulations shall be deemed to have been served on that person by serving a copy of the notice or document—
 - (a) to that person if the person is a natural person;
 - (b) to the director, manager, company secretary or secretary or other similar officer of the company, body corporate or society if the person is a company, body corporate or society; or
 - (c) to the sole proprietor or partner of the firm if the person is a firm.

- (3) Notwithstanding subregulation (1), service of notification in Form 4 by the Tribunal on any person may be affected by sending the notification by way of registered post or electronic communication.
